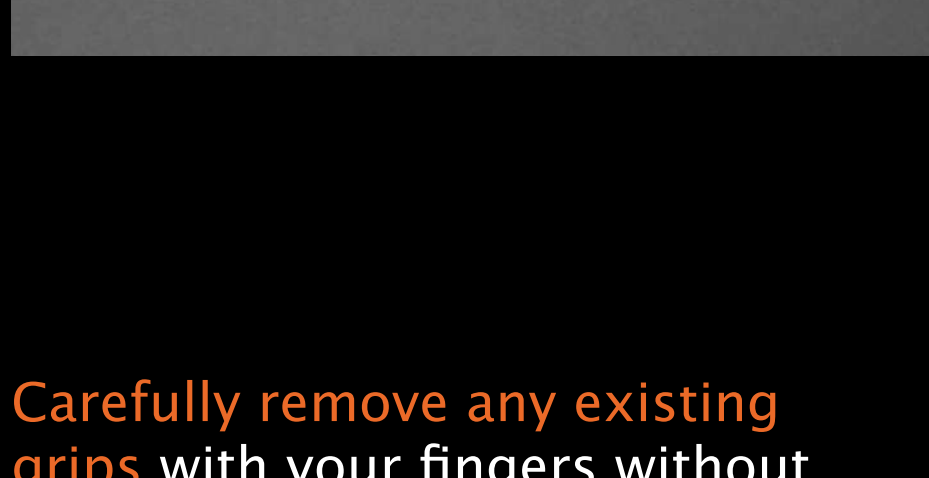


Manual for GRIPS

- 1 **Check** whether the supplied Corepad Grips fit the shape and the size of your mouse.



- 2 **Carefully remove any existing grips** with your fingers without damaging the mouse.

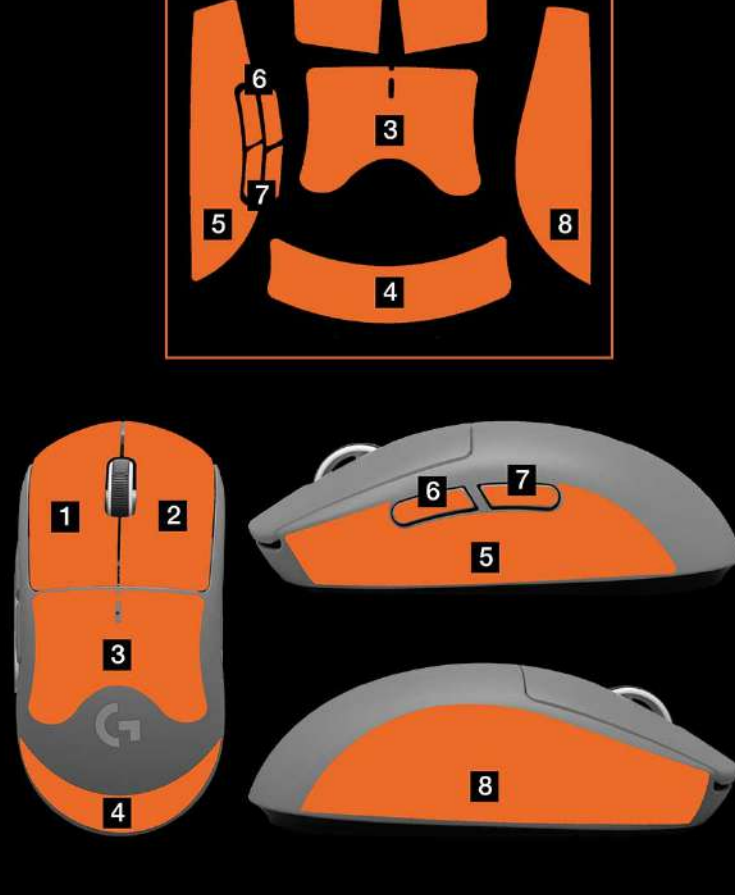


- 3 **Clean the surfaces thoroughly** with alcohol wipes and then leave the mouse to dry. Wash your hands first.



- 4 **Before you start: first think about** which grip needs to be glued to which position.

For example:



- 5 **Place the grip in the previously selected position.** Avoid finger contact with the adhesive as far as possible. Correct waves or bubbles before pressing firmly.



- 6 **If everything fits, press all the grips firmly with your fingers** – especially the edges.



Notes:

Use: Corepad Grips are completely dyed through – discolorations are therefore genuine soiling. For a long service life of the grips and to keep them clean, we recommend washing your hands before every use.

Cleaning: Corepad Grips can be easily cleaned with the supplied alcohol cleaning wipes. However, such cleaning should only be carried out when absolutely necessary – as little as possible.

Replacement: For intensive use, we recommend replacing the Corepad Grips every 3–5 months.

Storage: Always store Corepad Grips in the sealed original packaging in a cool, dark and dry place. Never store Corepad Grips together with alcohol wipes.
