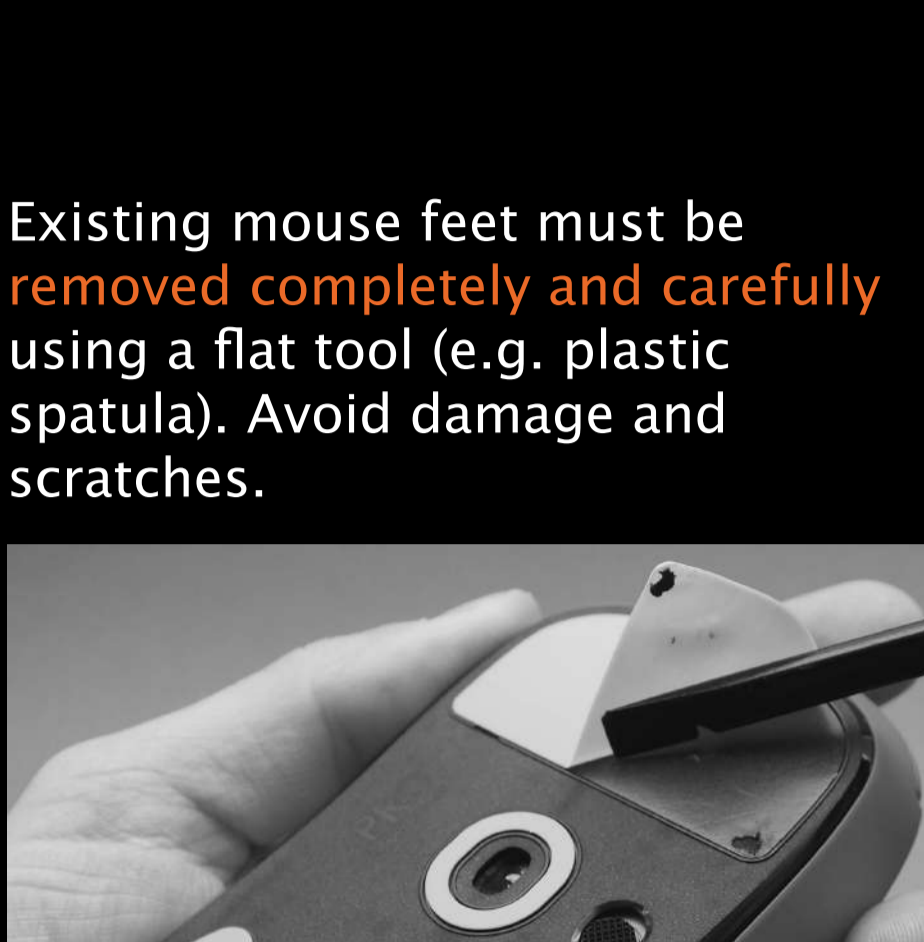
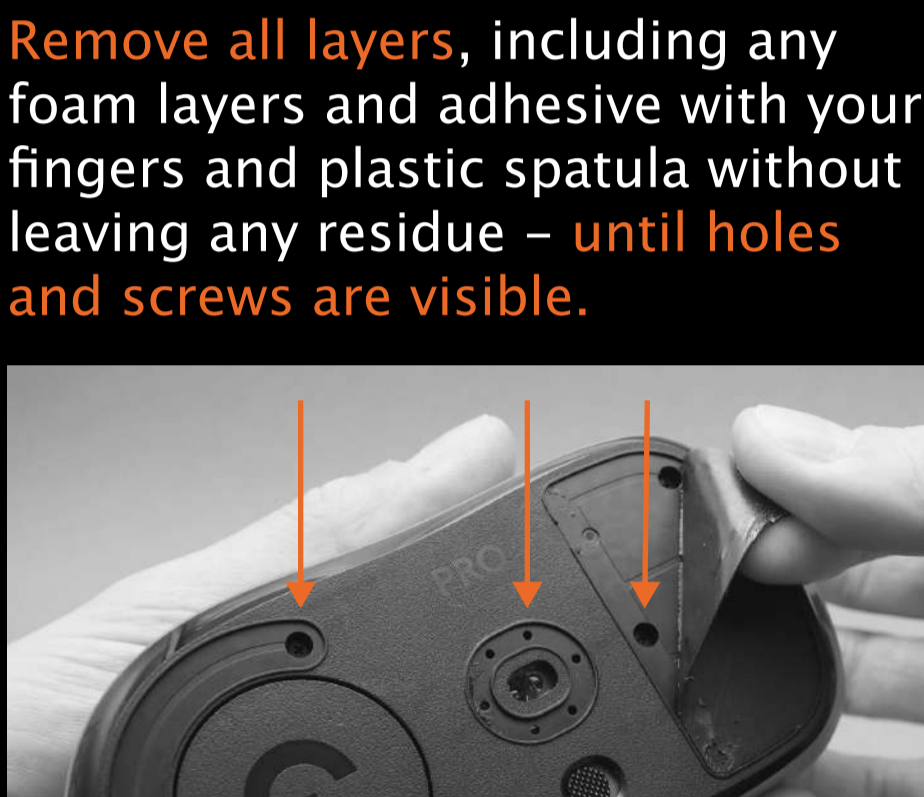


Manual for SKATEZ

- 1 **Check** whether the supplied Corepad Skatez fit the shape and the size of your mouse.



- 2 Existing mouse feet must be **removed completely and carefully** using a flat tool (e.g. plastic spatula). Avoid damage and scratches.



- 3 **Remove all layers**, including any foam layers and adhesive with your fingers and plastic spatula without leaving any residue – **until holes and screws are visible**.



- 4 **Clean the surfaces thoroughly** with alcohol wipes and then leave the mouse to dry.



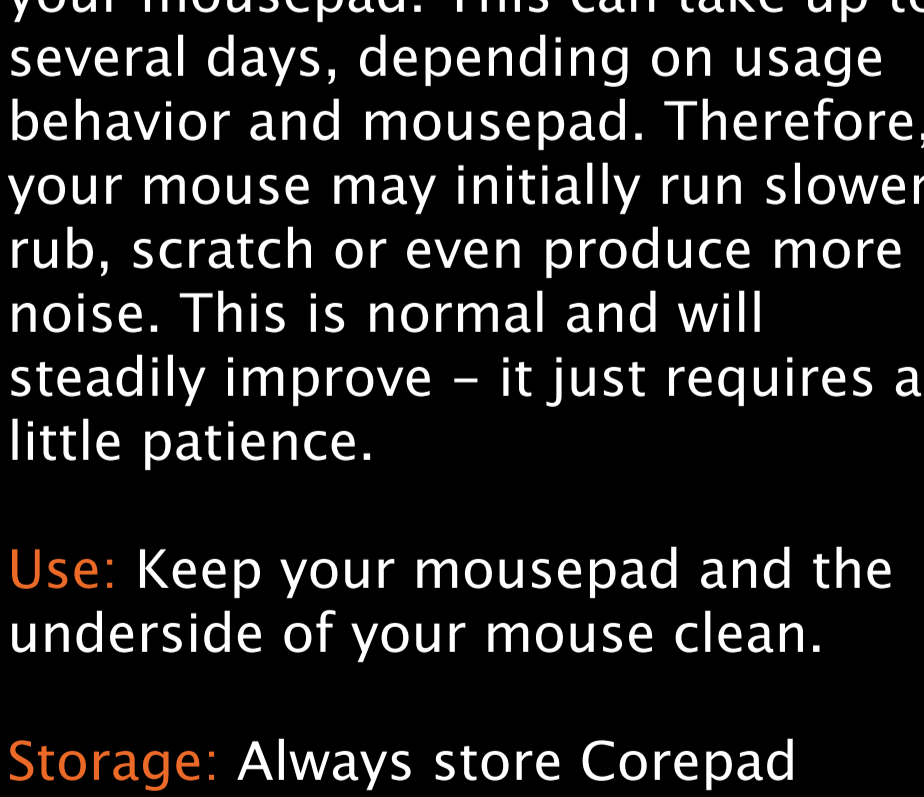
- 5 **Position the Corepad Skatez precisely and carefully** in the corresponding recesses or cut-outs without tilting. Make sure that they do not rest on any possible edges.



- 6 **Check again that the Corepad Skatez are correctly placed** in the corresponding recesses or cut-outs.



- 7 **Press firmly on each Corepad Skatez with your fingers**. Then press the mouse with a little pressure for approx. 30 seconds on a flat, firm surface.



Notes:

Break-In-Period: Skatez have a break-in period until friction and surface harmonize perfectly with your mousepad. This can take up to several days, depending on usage behavior and mousepad. Therefore, your mouse may initially run slower, rub, scratch or even produce more noise. This is normal and will steadily improve – it just requires a little patience.

Use: Keep your mousepad and the underside of your mouse clean.

Storage: Always store Corepad Skatez in the sealed original packaging in a cool, dark and dry place. Never store Corepad Skatez together with alcohol wipes.
